Heidi's Message ~ Communion is Center of Spiritual Life

Holy Communion is a huge deal for Lutherans, the very center of our spiritual lives, the tangible manifestation of the gospel, of Christ giving his broken body and his shed blood "for you." On Palm Sunday, seven FOG fifth graders will join us at the Lord's Table, but not only us.

When we gather in worship, we praise God with believers we cannot see. When we celebrate Holy Communion, we feast with past, present, and future disciples of Christ. We experience the communion of saints, the community of God's people—living and dead. This faith community stretches beyond space and time. We commune with Christians around the world, believers who came before us, and believers who

will come after us. We believe that the church is the communion of saints, and as a follower of Christ you belong to the communion of saints.

The apostle Paul uses the Greek word koinonia for communion. Koinonia describes a community bound together in faith and common experience. Koinonia richly depicts people of God coming together in hopes of harmony and worship of God. This is the deep and rich unity we celebrate as the communion of saints.

Join me in welcoming to the table these precious children of God. If you can, take time to welcome them and their families in the name of Christ.

A Moment with Martin (Luther)

The significance of the sacrament of Holy Communion should be understood against the background of Martin Luther's ideas of sin, falleness, and human despair. As he put it: "Though I am a sinner and I have fallen,

though this or that misfortune has befallen me, nevertheless I will go to the sacrament to receive a sign from God that I have on my side Christ's righteousness, life, and sufferings."

Changes at this year's Swedefest!


