Pastor Heidi's Reflections

Winter brain fog. Apparently it is a real thing, especially for those of us who are growing older. Contributing to brain fog are the lack of sunshine and the colder temperatures that keep us inside. For whatever reason, I have been keenly aware of it this winter. Let me share a few practices that have helped me.

1. Scheduling

Handwrite your daily schedule. If you handwrite it, you have a better chance of remembering what you wrote down.

2. Morning and night routines

Try to keep to the same routine every morning and night.

3. Set a ton of phone alarms

If you have a smart phone, use the alarm function to keep track of everything you wrote down on your schedule. This way even if your brain fog is bad, you don't have to worry about forgetting your plans for the day.

4. Give Yourself Time

Give yourself extra time to start your day. Create extra time for prayer and bible reading. You might even create a prayer journal. Write down the names of people for whom you want to pray each day. Then, send a card to the person for whom you prayed. If you are one who reads the newspaper every day, try to pray your way through it for a few days.

'Blessed Bottoms' needs diaper donations

First United Methodist in New Ulm has started a program called Blessed Bottoms, a diaper assistance program. The pastor there reported that they currently have 29 families registered to receive diapers, but only have about half as many diapers as needed. Blessed Bottoms will gratefully accept donations of diapers (all sizes except newborn—they have plenty), coupons, and diapering supplies (wipes, diaper cream, etc.).

Thrivent Associate membership can mean \$250 towards nearly any church project

FOG members are encouraged to consider applying for Thrivent "Associate Memberships" that cost just \$19.95 a year. Once enrolled, Associate Members can apply for a \$250/year Thrivent debit card that can be applied toward expenses related to any worthy church or non-profit community project. Some examples of projects that members have used Thrivent debit cards for include pizza to feed the volunteers for Food for Kids, advertising expenses for events (like ice cream social or Swedefest), food expense for special events, meal for Swedish college choir students, paper supplies for special events, supplies for quilts given to graduates, etc.

To enroll online, go to thrivent.com. Once the membership is set up, you may apply for the \$250 Action Team award online. Anyone needing help with applying by computer can contact Deb Sjostrom (507-276-0452) who would happily assist.

Those who are already Thrivent Benefit Members, and have annuities or policies, may apply for **two** \$250 debit cards each year. And, there are additional ways to give back with regular policies through Thrivent—contact Rosanne Johnson or your agent to learn how additional monies that can be given to your church or other non-profits.
