
















#### **Baptism at Bernadotte**

Food items used often are Juicy Juice boxes, Snack Pack puddings, individual fruit cups; microwaveable meals such as Mac 'n' cheese, ravioli, and Compleats meals; soups, and larger boxes of cereal for holiday or long weekends.

While the program really misses Pastor Heidi's input, the plan is to continue as long as possible. Donation envelopes are available at each church. They can be dropped in the collection plates or can be left at Citizens Bank MN, Lafayette.
